Sudan Foreign Minister Ali Karti has been invited to the 2015 National Prayer Breakfast. There's a few problems with that.

WAR & GENOCIDE

Mr. Karti was the commander of the Popular Defense Forces (PDF) of Sudan in the 1990s. Under his command, they butchered, raped, and plundered their way across southern Sudan during the country's long-running civil war. Today the PDF has been recycled into the Janjaweed and Rapid Support Forces.

KICKING OUT THE U.N.

Mr. Karti plays a major role in Sudanese government efforts to intimidate and kick U.N. humanitarian officials out of Sudan. This has had a devastating impact on relief efforts in Darfur, the Nuba Mountains, and Blue Nile, where government-sponsored violence against civilians is rapidly spreading.

WHO HE REPRESENTS

Mr. Karti represents the government of Sudan. The International Criminal Court (ICC) has issued several arrest warrants for Sudanese government officials on charges of war crimes, crimes against humanity, and genocide. Mr. Karti represents the interests of these individuals who are still killing and raping innocent people with impunity.
